**Want to know what's best? Just take the test!**

Right until the very moment it occurs, most crime victims are unaware of their vulnerability. Awakening to the sound of breaking glass and footsteps, or arriving home to find an ugly scene is NOT the time to consider installing a home security system. **Here's a simple test you can take to bring your specific level of vulnerability clearly into focus.**

Want to know if a burglar would consider your home a rewarding target? **REVIEW EACH QUESTION IN THE FOUR CATEGORIES BELOW, AND SIMPLY PLACE A CHECKMARK NEXT TO THE ONES THAT APPLY.** The likelihood of your home being selected as a burglar's rewarding target increases based upon the following factors:

**1. Where you Live: Assign 2 Points per Positive Response**

- Your home is located in a generally affluent area
- Your home is newer, considerably more expensive or noticeable
- Your home is located in a sparsely populated, suburban or rural area
- Police protection in your area is considered to be marginal or poor
- Your neighbor(s) have suffered a burglary, vandalism or break-in
- Your area, in general, has experienced an increase in crime
- Your home is located on a cul-de-sac or near a school building
- You live in a vacation or leisure community area
- Your neighborhood is generally unoccupied during the day due to work schedules
- Your neighborhood experiences a high level of property owner transition
- You have experienced a burglary within the past two years

**2. The Home You Live In: Assign 3 Points per Positive Response**

- Your home contains collectibles of any kind
- Your home contains desirable audio, video or computer components
- You operate a "home office" with business equipment out of the location
- You store jewelry, silver or guns in your home
- Household pets are left alone in the home during periods of time
- Your home is designed with decks, patio doors, or easily accessible windows
- Your home has a detached garage containing tools that could assist a burglar
- Your home has locks that could be easily defeated
- Your home is situated with one or more blind spots where unobserved entry could be made

**3. Your Lifestyle: Assign 4 Points per Positive Response**

- Your home is vacant during daily hours due to the working schedules of the occupants
- Your daily schedule is highly predictable. You leave and arrive home at approximately the same time each day
- You vacation often, or the same time each year, or you take frequent business trips
- Your home is used as a secondary or vacation home and is occupied only on occasion

**4. Your Personal Safety Concerns: Assign 5 Points per Positive Response**

- Your career or position creates an increased level of exposure to the public, publicity or notoriety
- A family member has experienced a personal security concern including threats by telephone, mail or electronic mail, or has experienced an actual violation including personal or sexual assault, harassment, etc.
- School-aged children arrive home to an empty house due to the occupants' work schedules
- A member of the family suffers from a physical or medical condition that may require emergency assistance from the authorities
- You live in a neighborhood where personal safety is a constant concern
- Concerns about personal safety are interfering with a normal lifestyle
